### **Rules for Mathematics remedial class**

- 1) No unexcused absences are allowed; medical leave or leave with a parent's note must be provided to avoid a demerit.
  - 2) A leave letter must be submitted to the Mathematics teacher within three days after illness or leave.
  - 3) If class times conflict with known school activities or self-funded learning activities, prior approval from the Mathematics teacher is required for exemption.
  - 4) Students must focus in class and respect the teacher. No playing, sleeping, or eating in the classroom; violations will result in disciplinary action according to school rules.
  - 5) Mobile phones are not allowed; violations will result in disciplinary action according to school rules.
  - 6) Please keep the classroom tidy.
  - 7) Each class will have designated students responsible for cleaning the blackboard, arranging desks and chairs, closing windows and doors, and turning off all electrical switches before leaving.
